**Coast Central Recognized as Top-Performing, High Asset Credit Union  
by Raddon Financial Group**

**Eureka** – Raddon Financial Group (RFG), a strategic business unit of Open Solutions, Inc., recently presented its Crystal Performance Award to Coast Central Credit Union as a high-performing credit union. Dean G. Christensen, Coast Central Credit Union's President/CEO, accepted the award.

The Crystal Performance Award was designed to recognize credit unions for achieving a top ten ranking based on the RFG Performance Index, a balanced scorecard measurement of growth, income, efficiency and margin management. RFG recognized the top credit unions above \$500 million in assets based on their 2008 performance.

More than 500 credit unions were evaluated for the Crystal Performance Award through RFG's CEO Strategies Group program. Each of the winners ranked among the top two or three percent of all credit unions analyzed by RFG for two consecutive reporting periods in 2008.
