## SCHOLARSHIP ANNOUNCEMENT

Coast Central Credit Union is the largest and the oldest locally-owned financial institution in the counties we serve. A major purpose of the credit union is to strengthen the community where we live and work. The Board of Directors of Coast Central believes that supporting education is an effective way to ensure the future strength of our community, as well as support the aspirations of our youth.

The Scholarship Committee of Coast Central Credit Union is interested in assisting a broad spectrum of students who intend to continue their education. Up to 13 scholarships may be awarded to qualified applicants based on demonstrated commitment to education, either through outstanding academic performance or through consistent improvement during their high school years, as well as financial need.

### VALUE:

The scholarships are disbursed over a four-year period. For the first and second years the amount is **\$1,000** per year. For the third and fourth years, the value is increased to **\$1,500** each year for a potential total value of **\$5,000**. To receive the entire scholarship, students must attend Humboldt State University, College of the Redwoods, Shasta Community College, or Chico State University and maintain at least a "C" or better GPA.

If after the completion of the first two years of undergraduate full-time course of study, Humboldt State University or Chico State University does not offer the specialized program or major the recipient has chosen to pursue, the recipient may provide a letter to Coast Central to request an exception to the Scholarship "Specific College/University" requirement. The letter should include the alternative school of choice, verification of acceptance, and an explanation of the specialized program or major desired, and the scholarship may continue for the next two years.

#### **QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Student must be a graduating senior from a high school located in Humboldt, Del Norte or Trinity County.
- Students must apply and be accepted to attend College of the Redwoods, Humboldt State University, Shasta Community College, or Chico State University as a full-time student (12 units or more) for the Fall 2021 semester.
- 3. Applicant must have a high school grade average of "C" or better.
