COLLEGE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

Established in 1950, Coast Central Credit Union is the largest locally-owned financial institution in the counties we serve. With a People Helping People focus, a major purpose of the credit union is to strengthen the community where we live and work.

Our Board of Directors believes that supporting education is an effective way to ensure the future strength of our community, as well as support the aspirations of local youth. **Up to 25 four-year scholarships** will be awarded to qualified applicants based on the following:

- Financial Need
- 200-word Essay
- Academic performance or improvement
- Community and/or school involvement

AMOUNTS:

Scholarships are disbursed over a four-year period. For the first and second years the amount is **\$1,000** per year. For the third and fourth years, the value is increased to **\$1,500** each year for a potential total value of **\$5,000**. To receive the entire scholarship, students must attend Cal Poly Humboldt, College of the Redwoods, Shasta Community College, or Chico State University.

Exceptions: If after the completion of the first two years of undergraduate study, Cal Poly Humboldt or Chico State University does not offer the specialized program or major the recipient has chosen to pursue, the recipient may provide a letter to Coast Central to request an exception to the Scholarship "Specific College/University" requirement. The letter should include the alternative school of choice, verification of acceptance, and an explanation of the specialized program or major desired. The scholarship may continue for the next two years.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a **graduating senior** from a high school located in Humboldt, Del Norte or Trinity County.
- Must be accepted to attend **College of the Redwoods, Cal Poly Humboldt, Shasta College, or Chico State University** as a full-time student for Fall 2023.
